- She published the first Directory of Lodge Members shortly after joining in 2004.
- She has been the Food Team leader for our St. Joseph's Day Festival since the beginning six (6) years ago.
- Both Armando and Barbara have led the team in the 3-day task of cooking sauce and meatballs (Barbara's family's recipes), as well as, running the kitchen on the festival days.
- They have been a force behind the growth of this Lodge for the last 12 years.
- They continue to be involved in their current roles as Co-Historians.
